

The Rincon Ranger Foundation Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

The Rincon Ranger Foundation will be offering **A \$1,500 Millie McEvoy Scholarship in honor of Dennis McEvoy's mother, \$1500 Grijalva Family Scholarship and 4 - \$1,000 Ranger Scholarships to eligible seniors. Applications are due April 6, 2025** and winners will be notified by the end of April. Scholarships may be used to attend an Arizona state-accredited college, trade school or university. Payment will be made directly to the institution and may be applied to tuition, fees, housing and books. If a student fails to complete coursework, monies on account will be refunded to the Foundation.

Who is Eligible?

A student is **eligible** to be considered for a Rincon Ranger Foundation Scholarship if the student meets all the following criteria:

- Has attained a cumulative high school GPA of 3.00 or better and will have completed all state and district graduation requirements at Rincon High School, by May 22, 2025.
- Will enroll for the first time at an Arizona accredited college, tech school or university in the fall as a full time, degree-seeking, student and who can provide proof of acceptance and enrollment in that college or university.
- Has demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service and extracurricular activities.
- Has completed and submitted the application form, provided two letters of recommendation from a teacher, administrator, counselor or coach and completed a short essay of 300 words or less explaining why you feel deserving of this scholarship. The essay will be evaluated on proper grammar, content, and communication. Do your best.
- Income level is not considered in eligibility.
